

Joseph Evans is Director of the Networking & Distributed Systems Laboratory of the Information & Telecommunication Technology Center and is the Spahr Professor of Electrical Engineering & Computer Science at the University of Kansas. His research interests include ubiquitous computing systems, high speed networks, mobile and wireless networking, and adaptive computing systems. He has been involved in major national high performance networking testbeds and broadband wireless mobile networking efforts. Dr. Evans has published over 70 journal and conference works. He has been a researcher at the Olivetti & Oracle Research Laboratory, Cambridge University Computer Laboratory, USAF Rome Laboratories, and AT&T Bell Laboratories. He was co-founder and member of the board of directors of a network gaming company recently acquired by Microsoft. Dr. Evans received his PhD degree from Princeton University in 1989, and is a member of the IEEE and ACM.
