Mr. Hatch received a Bachelors Degree in Electrical Engineering from Washington State University, Pullman, Washington and a Masters Degree in communications from George Washington University.

Mr. Hatch has been involved in management of the Radio Frequency Spectrum with particular attention to inter-service sharing and compatibility studies while working at the department of Defense Electromagnetic Compatibility Analysis Center and at the National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA). He has been a member of the U.S. delegation to the ITU World Radio Conferences and served as vice chairman and U.S. spokesperson in numerous Committees and Working Groups of the Conference. He has been responsible for recommendations to the NTIA Interdepartment Radio Advisory Committee for implementing the results of these Conferences for the Federal Government.

Mr. Hatch was Program Manager of the Spectrum Plans Program in the Office of Spectrum Management responsible for issues addressing spectrum management, technical standards, and regulations in both the national and international fora.

He is presently the Acting Associate Administrator for the Office of Spectrum Management AT NTIA and the chairman of the Interdepartment Radio Advisory Committee.
