

David V. Rogers received a BS, Physics, from Lamar University, Beaumont, Texas, in 1967 and a PhD, Physics, from North Texas University, Denton, in 1973. From 1973 to 1976, he worked in the Radio and Radar Research Directorate of the Communications Research Centre, Ottawa, Canada. From 1976 to 1977, he was a member of the engineering staff of ORI, Inc., Silver Spring, MD. In 1977, he joined COMSAT Laboratories, Clarksburg, MD, where he performed theoretical and experimental research and development on radiowave propagation for application to satellite communications. During his last several years at COMSAT, he was Manager of the Propagation Studies Department. In June 1990, he rejoined the Communications Research Centre as Group Leader, Earth-Space Propagation, in the Radio Sciences Branch. He is a Vice-Chair of Study Group 3 of the ITU Radiocommunication Sector (ITU-R), and a member of the IEEE, URSI Commission F, and the American Geophysical Union.
