VQEG has started a new work item under the AVHD project. This work item includes the evaluation of video quality assessment models targeting at adaptive bitrate streaming. The detailed requirements shall be worked out during the next meeting of VQEG (Feb. 29 - March 4 2016 in San Diego). For the time being the Project synopsis which is available for download here:

The outcome of this project will be a test report indicating the performance of all tested models that will be sent to ITU with the request to standardize one or multiple of the tested models if they are felt to be mature enough. This preliminary interest to participate shall be confirmed once the exact requirements are known.
